2020 Application Guide

1. Introduction

The CivicInfo BC Leadership and Governance Award is funded by an anonymous donor to provide assistance to employees of local government and First Nation governments in Canada pursuing educational opportunities in governance and leadership.

2. Eligible Applicants

The Award is open to employees of Local Government and First Nation Government across Canada. The area of study must be post-secondary and focused on leadership and/or governance.

3. Application Criteria

- a. Applicants will be employees of:
 - a. Canadian Local Governments (excluding police and fire services)
 - b. Canadian First Nations Governments
- b. Consideration will be given at any stage in educational development but must be prior to the start of a new course or term, including one-time training events.
- c. Financial Need – assessed on whether the employer will cover the costs associated with the training including the fees for the course, travel and accommodation.
- d. Type of Education
 - a. Directly related to local government pursuits
 - b. Scope of training meets leadership and governance supporting administrative operations
- e. Demonstrated Commitment – Evaluation of impact on and value to the community the applicant serves

4. Application Process

The application will be submitted through the CivicInfo BC online portal. The link <https://form.surveypal.net/CivicInfo-BC-Leadership-and-Governance-Award> will be made live September 14th. In addition to completing the application, applicants will be asked to provide:

- a. A letter of reference signed by the employer, a peer, an academic advisor or another individual known to the applicant in a professional context outlining commitment to their endeavour.
- a. Proof of registration or enrolment must also be attached to the online application.

Only complete applications will be considered.

5. Application deadline

For 2020 the application deadline is October 23rd at 4pm. The award recipient will be contacted following the committee's decision.

6. Review of Applications

CivicInfo BC staff will perform a preliminary review of all applications to ensure the required application criteria are met and submitted in full. The CivicInfo BC Leadership and Governance Award committee will review the applications and score each based on the application criteria. The committee will then make the final decision on the successful applicant.

7. Payment to Recipient

The 2020 award will be \$1,000. Once the award recipient is determined, 75% of the award will be remitted to the recipient. The remaining 25% will be paid out upon submission of an impact statement following completion of the training.
